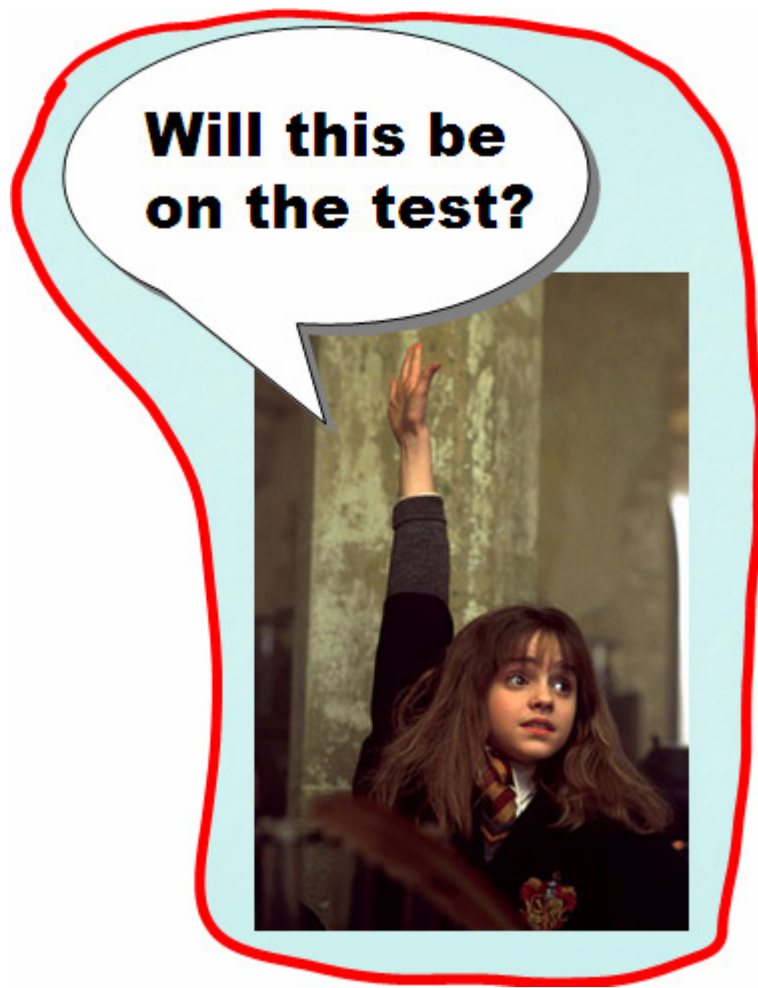
Office Hours
